sit	[bereits in Unit 2]	sitzen
sit down	Sit down, please.	sich (hin-)setzen
stand	You have to stand in a queue.	stehen
stand up	When the teacher comes into the classroom, the students stand up.	aufstehen (vom Stuhl)
get up	It's time to get up.	aufstehen (vom Bett)
get fit	Do sports to get fit.	fit werden, in Form kommen
go to bed	Jamie goes to bed at nine o'clock.	ins Bett gehen
sleep	At night the cat sleeps in the kitchen.	schlafen
fall asleep	When I go to bed, I fall asleep right away.	einschlafen
[fall over]	I often laugh so much I fall over.	hinfallen, umkippen
ask	Teachers always ask silly questions.	fragen
talk	Have you got a problem? Talk to me.	sprechen; reden
speak	Luke's mother speaks English and Polish.	Sprechen
chat	Olivia often chats with Pia.	plaudern, chatten [sich online unterhalten]
take	You can't take pets to school. You can't take your partner's ruler. Take this schoolbag to the office.	(mit-)nehmen; wegnehmen; (hin-)bringen [mitbringen??]
[bring	[aus Unit2]	(her-, mit-)bringen]
put	Put the pen on the table. Put your bike into the shed.	setzen, legen, stellen
look	Where's my pen? – Look in your schoolbag. He looks tired today.	schauen, sehen, ausschauen
look for sth.	Holly looks for her schoolbag.	suchen
find out	Find out what the story is about.	herausfinden
have	Have a sweet. /Have a sandwich.	nehmen, essen
have breakfast	We have breakfast at half past seven..	frühstücken
have fun	Pia has fun at school.	Spaß haben, sich amüsieren

be careful	Be careful! [Vorsicht! Pass auf!]	aufpassen
be about	The book is about pets.	handeln von, gehen (um)
be good at	Luke is <u>good at</u> football.	gut sein <u>in</u> etwas
be scared of	[<i>I'm not scared of</i> ist bereits in Unit 1]	Angst haben
be in the way	Am I in the way?	im Weg sein/stehen
make	Luke's mum often makes a cake. Make a sentence with "bark".	machen, tun, bilden
[do Unit 2]	Do your homework.	machen, tun
listen (for)	Sherlock always listens for Luke's voice.	horchen auf
listen (to)	Olivia often listens to music. Teacher: "Listen to me."	(sich) anhören, zuhören, herhören
stop	Stop making a noise. Stop the car.	aufhören (mit), anhalten, stoppen, [stehen bleiben]
bark	Sherlock barks when he sees Luke.	bellen
chase	Sherlock often chases squirrels in the park.	(nach-)jagen
run away	Cats often run away when they see a dog.	wegrennen (-laufen)
tidy (up)	Holly tidies (up) her room every day.	aufräumen
wash	Luke washes your hands before lunch.	(sich) waschen
throw (at)	Don't throw snowballs at cars.	werfen (nach, auf)
visit	Luke sometimes visits his friends. Let's visit Buckingham Palace.	besuchen, besichtigen
improve	Pia wants to improve her English.	(sich) verbessern
warm up	Luke warms up before a football game.	(sich) aufwärmen
act	Can you act that scene?	(Theaterrolle) spielen
describe	Can you describe your room?	beschreiben
open	Can you open the window.	öffnen, aufmachen
[close]	[in Unit 4, als Imperative in Unit 1]	schließen, zumachen
hold	Anna and Jack sometimes hold hands.	(fest-) halten
come	Luke's friends come to his house.	kommen
walk	You can walk to school. (Gegensatz zu: <i>fahren</i> : <i>laufen</i> >)	(zu Fuß) gehen, laufen
ride	You can ride a bike or a horse.)	fahren, reiten
