Some-any

I've got **some** fantastic things in my room: What about your room?

I've got **some** posters on the wall. **Have you** got **any** posters on the wall?

I've got **some** books on my shelf. **Have you** got **any** books on the shelf?

I've got **some** CD-ROMs for my computer. **Have you** got **any** CD-ROMs for your computer?

I've got **some** CDs on my CD-player. **Have you** got **any** CDs on your CD-player?.

I've got **some** computer games. **Have you** got **any** good computer games?

I've got **some** computer magazines. **Have you** got **any** interesting computer magazines?

I've got **some** old records. Have you got any good records?
